Welcome new freshmen and returning band students! Now is the time to register for the 2016/2017 Grizzly Band by completing the attached form. For many of the people in our community the Grizzly Band is the most important of all our ensembles. It is the band they will see at sporting events and parades and it helps build pride in our school and our music program. All freshmen band members are required to be in the Grizzly Band and attend Band Camp. This is how you earn points toward a Varsity Letter. We perform for the home football games, assemblies and pep rallies and we march in the Homecoming and Snohomish Easter Parades.

Marching practices during football season are Thursdays from 7-9 pm, the week of a football game. During basketball season, we play at 10 home games and to letter it's required that you play at a minimum of 5 games. There are no rehearsals during basketball season because of the large number of performances. Student participation in "away" tournaments (basketball playoffs) will be determined by attendance at home games. Dates and times of possible playoff games will be announced at a later date.

You will receive a Pep Band T-Shirt to be worn at *all* Pep Band events (excluding in-school pep assemblies) and uniforms for the football games. Please be sure to indicate T-shirt size on the registration form.

The Grizzly Band fee of \$145.00 is used to hire instructors, write the show, provide music, uniform rental, uniform alterations & cleaning, transportation to and from the games, Husky Band Day and a Grizzly Band t-shirt. **Grizzly Band Fee payment is due June 1st along with student's registration forms, even if student is unable to attend band camp.**

The purpose of Grizzly Band Camp is to learn the music and marching formations. Attendance is highly recommended. Camp runs each day from 8:00am to 4:00pm with an hour break for lunch.
