Available to cover and Grizzly Band fees, concert attire costs, and required field trip fees (cannot cover touring ensemble costs or optional activity costs) – all requests confidential



Earning a Varsity Letter in Band

Available to members of Grizzly Band

Students in all grades can join during the football season or the beginning of the basketball season

Attendance Points Awarded

Daily at band camp – Grizzly Band Rehearsals – Performances - Parades

Varsity Letter Earned when 150 points received

Students can use some outside activities – no more than 15 points



Senior Scholarships

Three awards of \$500 to graduating seniors

Applications open in late March/early April

Must be a senior enrolled in a band class this year and plan to attend a university or vocational program during the Fall term

Minimum 2.75 GPA

Must earn a varsity letter at least once during high school

Parents of incoming freshmen evaluate applications anonymously and vote for scholarship awards
