

## Earning a Varsity Letter in Band

#### Available to members of Grizzly Band

Students in all grades can join during the football season or the beginning of the basketball season

#### Attendance Points Awarded

Daily at band camp – Grizzly Band Rehearsals – Performances - Parades

#### Varsity Letter Earned when 150 points received

Students can use some outside activities – no more than 15 points



# Senior Scholarships

#### Three awards of \$500 to graduating seniors

Applications open in late March/early April

Must be a senior enrolled in a band class this year and plan to attend a university or vocational program during the Fall term

Minimum 2.75 GPA

Must earn a varsity letter at least once during high school

Parents of incoming freshmen evaluate applications anonymously and vote for scholarship awards

## Required Fees & Costs

#### Concert Uniforms

Polos about \$39-44 – Dresses about \$70

#### Wind Ensemble Field Trips

Field trips – flat cost of \$90 – payable to school bookkeeper

#### Concert – Symphonic – Jazz – Percussion Ensemble

Field trips – flat cost of \$30 – payable to bookkeeper


